1. A squirrel's teeth never stop growing.
their teeth down. True – *Eating hard nuts help wear*
2. Groundhogs are nocturnal.
Groundhogs are diurnal meaning they are awake during the day. Silly – *Nocturnal means awake at*
3. A mother opossum carries her babies in her pouch or on her back.
pouch they ride on her back until they are old enough to live on their own. True – *When they get too big for her*
4. Raccoons can have up to 13 babies in one litter.
5 babies at a time. True – *But they usually only have 3-*
5. Flying squirrels are bigger than tree squirrels.
small. Silly – *Flying squirrels are very*
6. If you touch a baby rabbit, it's mother will not come back.
but PLEASE DO NOT TOUCH baby rabbits. Silly – *The mother will come back,*
7. Groundhogs hibernate in the winter.
deep sleep. True – *Hibernate means to go into a*
8. Chipmunks can fill their cheeks with seeds. True
9. Opossum have 20 teeth. Silly – *they have about 50 teeth*
10. Wild animals make good pets.
hold a wild animal. They can BITE. They DO NOT make good pets. Silly – *Never touch, pet, or try to*
11. A squirrel's nest is made of leaves. True
12. Raccoons are most active at night. True
13. A skunk can spray up to 50 feet.
don't even try to get that close! Pew!! Silly – *it can spray up to 15 feet, but*
14. Flying squirrels are not able to fly.
between their front legs & back legs, this allows them to GLIDE thru the air, not fly. They do not flap their wings like a bird does. True – *They have skin stretching*
15. It is against the law to keep wild animals as pets.
hurt, tell your parents to call your local Wildlife Rehabilitation Clinic. True – *if you find an animal that is*
